

TEES ROWING CLUB – EVENT PARKING

NOTE – IMPORTANT CHANGES TO 2022 PARKING – PLEASE READ

Warning – All drivers are asked to approach car parks and allocated spaces carefully – this is particularly relevant with trailer drivers who are asked to take extra care and to be alert to any passing vehicles when entering and exiting trailer parks. Please follow all instructions given by the on-site marshals.

VISITOR PARKING

Tees Rowing Club events are held at the River Tees Watersports Centre (RTWC), The Slipway, North Shore, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 2NL.

We have several free car parks available to us on the day (all close to RTWC) all provided on a first come, first served basis, and to make best use would appreciate all users following the guidance below.

Please note there is **NO** parking available on the roads surrounding RTWC as this is fully open to traffic and double yellow lines are in place.

Trailers and vehicles with roof mounted boats (refer to maps 1 and 2)

The RTWC car park is exclusively reserved for trailers with boats only (vehicles with roof mounted boats are not permitted at RTWC). This space is limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Once trailers are in place, all towing vehicles must be moved to one of the allocated competitor's car parks.

Parking for trailers and vehicles with roof mounted boats is available at the Riverside Car Park (**new for 2022**) a short walk to the west of RTWC, marked on the maps as "Trailer Park". **Please note that the former trailer park is no longer in use and will be locked.** A new pontoon has been installed adjacent to the Riverside Car Park for direct access on/off the water. Marshals will be in attendance to assist with parking and boating – please follow their instructions. Once trailers are in place, all towing vehicles (excluding vehicles carrying roof mounted boats) must be moved to one of the allocated car parks a short walk away (see below).

Competitors and spectators arriving by car (refer to maps 1 and 2)

Competitors and spectators arriving by car are asked to use the "Fusion Hive" office car park and the "Dugdale Street" car park signposted as "Northshore One". Please respect any reserved or coned off spaces.

Parking for disabled badge holders is available at the Fusion Hive car park.

Additional parking

If all the above car parks are full, additional parking is situated at the Barrage on the south side of the river, accessed from Navigation Way (TS17 6QA) which is a short walk along the footpath and across the Infinity Bridge (a good vantage point to watch the racing on regatta day). There are also several pay and display car parks close to RTWC.

Emergency Vehicles

At all times, please park in a way that will allow emergency vehicle access to the Centre and the waterfront. Please also respect local road users and enable vehicles and trailers to arrive and leave throughout the day.

Valuables

If you leave valuables in your vehicles, make sure that they are out of sight. Tees Rowing Club does not accept any liability for loss or damage of property.

Litter

Please make sure that you take all litter with you or use the bins provided.

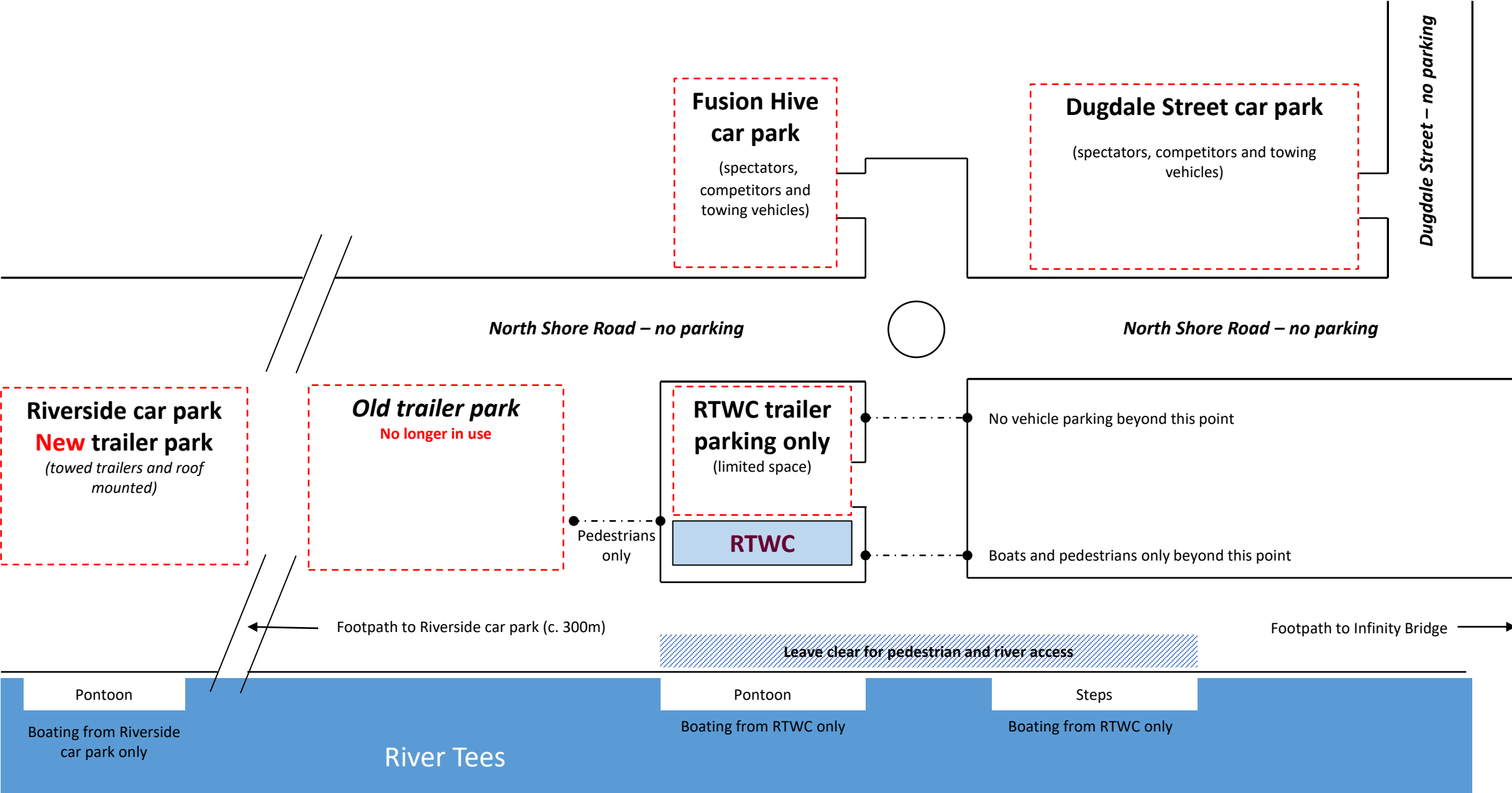
