IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARKING – PLEASE READ

Disclaimer - Users of all vehicle and trailer parks do so at their own risk. Tees Rowing Club does not accept responsibility or liability for damage, accident, or loss, howsoever arising.

Warning – Drivers are requested to approach all car parks and spaces patiently and carefully – this is particularly important with trailer drivers who are asked to take extra care and to be alert and considerate to any passing or following vehicles when entering and exiting trailer parks. Please follow all instructions given by the on-site marshals.

Tees Rowing Club events are held at: River Tees Watersports Centre (RTWC), The Slipway, North Shore, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 2NL.

We have several car parks available, all provided on a first come, first served basis. All users are asked to follow the guidance below. Please also refer to the attached maps for directions.

Trailers and vehicles carrying roof mounted boats:

There are two trailer parks which will be **allocated ahead of the event**. Both trailer parks have river access. Marshals will be in attendance to assist with parking and boating – please follow their instructions.

All trailer towers are asked to take note of the following instructions and of their pre-allocated trailer park.

Please also note that if approaching RTWC from the west, there are lane (not road) closures on the Riverside A1305 (illustrated on the attached maps). Trailer towers may want to use an alternative route.

The two trailer parks are as follows; directions are shown below and please follow these instructions.

- 1) River Tees Watersports Centre, The Slipway, North Shore Rd, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 2NL.
 - a. Trailer drivers should head directly to the RTWC on arrival if they are allocated spaces here. Once trailers are in place, all towing vehicles must be moved to one of the allocated visitor's car parks.
- 2) Riverside car park, Riverside, Stockton-on-Tees TS18 1TE.
 - a. To manage the flow of trailers on arrival and reduce the effect on other road users, all trailers with allocated spaces at Riverside car park must first head to the holding zone on arrival, and not directly to the Riverside Car Park.
 - b. The holding zone is in the lay-bys off the Council of Europe Blvd, across the Princess of Wales Bridge, a very short distance from the Riverside car park (map attached). Marshals will be in attendance to direct and assist trailer drivers and trailers will be released systematically by the marshals and sent directly to the Riverside Car Park. This system should not cause delays and will make setting up on arrival a safer and more efficient process.

Visitors' car parks

Car parks are provided on a first come, first served basis and are all a short walk to the club. These car parks must not be used for trailer parking. There are several pay and display car parks close to RTWC.

Please be aware that the Fusion Hive car park opposite RTWC is no longer available for visitor parking.

Limited parking for disabled badge holders is available at the Fusion Hive and Northshore One car parks.

- 1) Northshore One – North Shore Rd, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 2NB – **car only**.
- 2) Northshore One – Dugdale Street, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 2NE – **car only**.
- 3) Dairy car park - Bishop Street, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1TE – **car only**.
- 4) Durham University, Ebsworth Building, Stockton-on-Tees, TS17 6BH - **car, minibus, and coach parking**.

Valuables

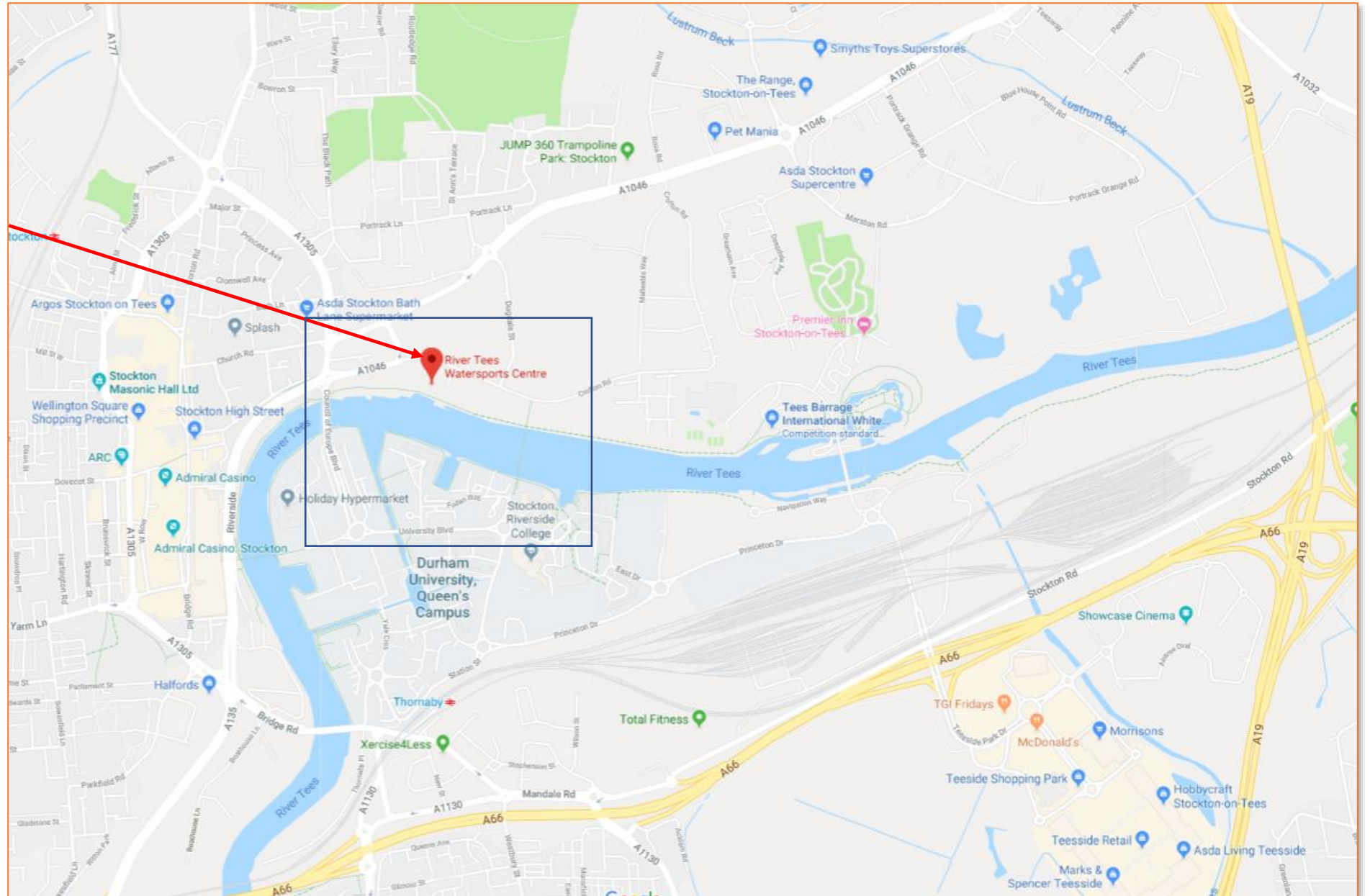
If you leave valuables in your vehicles, make sure that they are out of sight. Tees Rowing Club does not accept any liability for loss or damage of property.

Litter

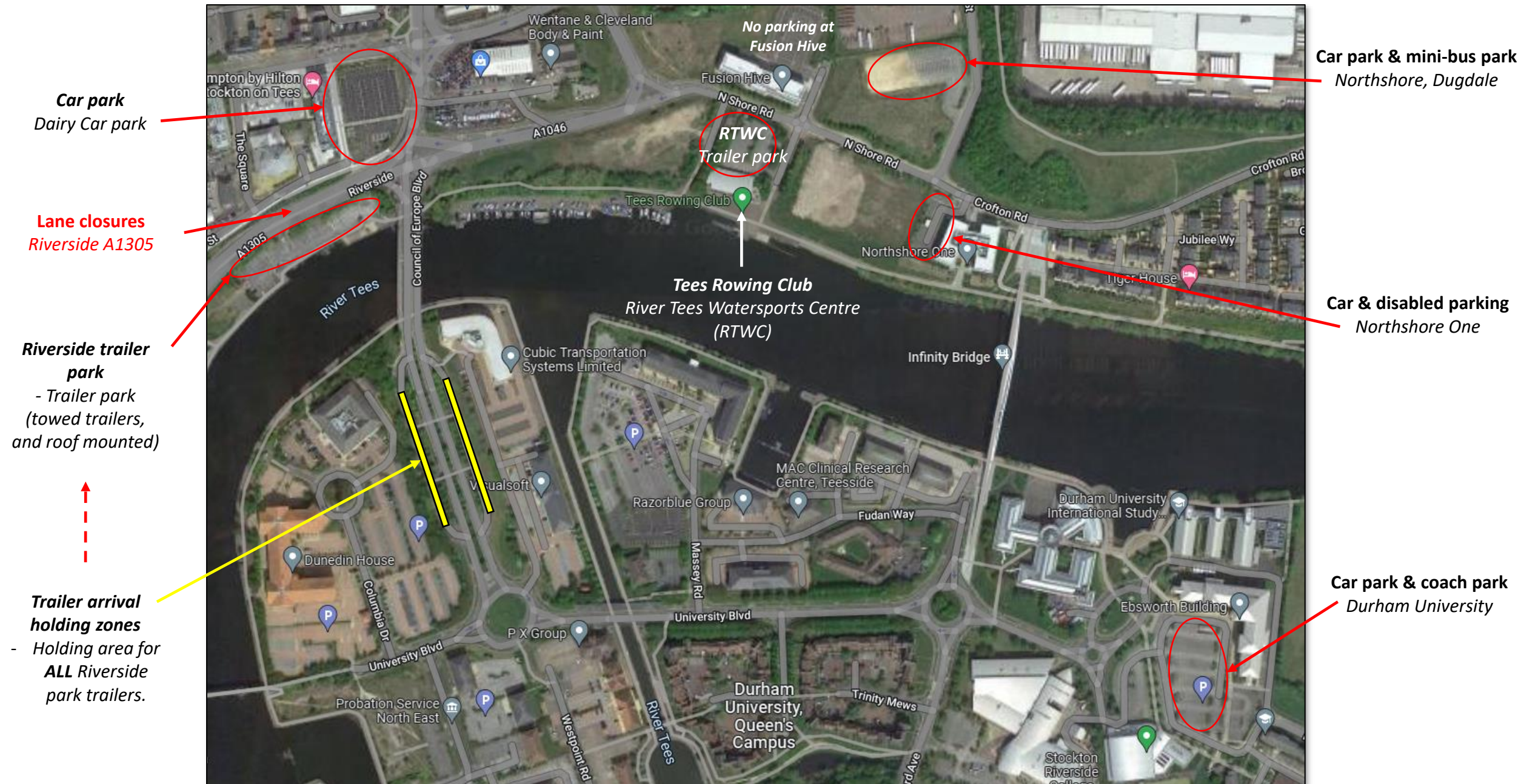
Please make sure that you take all litter with you or use the bins provided.

Notes for visitors

- Both trailer parks have direct river access and boating is via pontoons located at each park.
- Marshals will be on site to direct and assist with trailer parking and boating.
- **All trailers with spaces allocated at Riverside car park must first head to the holding zone** shown on the map.
- Pedestrian access to Tees Rowing Club from Durham University car park is a short walk across the Infinity Bridge
- Pedestrian access to Tees Rowing Club from Riverside trailer park is a short walk along Riverside footpath
- Pedestrian crossings should be used to access Tees Rowing Club from Dairy car park
- No general or towing vehicle parking is permitted at Tees Rowing Club
