Questions a coach or Club Official on any aspects of safety which cause concern or lack clarity.		
Before an Outing		
Understands environmental factors (Temperature, Wind, Flow).		
Demonstrates choice of clothing appropriate to conditions.		
Understands personal flotation devices (differences/when to use).		
Understands Boat Booking system.		
Understands different types of boats (Stability, Crew Weight, Restrictions).		
Demonstrates safe lifting technique remove boat from racking to trestles and from trestles to pontoon (Slip risk,		
Pedestrians and Cyclists).		
Demonstrates basic boat safety check (Hull, Fin, Hatches, Seat, Slides, Shoes, Heel Restraints, Steering Mechanism,		
Rudder, Rigger Security, Swivel Height and Pitch, Oar Collars and Handles).		
Demonstrates how to adjust equipment to suit personal stature and requirement.		
Understands the significance of signing out correctly.		

During an Outing	
Understands the circulation pattern in front of the RTWC.	
Understands the navigation rules and potential hazards:	
From Infinity Bridge to Princess of Wales Bridge	
From Princess of Wales Bridge to Victoria Bridge	
From Victoria Bridge to Teal Bend	
From Teal Bend to Bassleton Wood/Jubilee Bridge	
Beyond Jubilee Bridge.	
Downstream from Infinity Bridge to the Barrage.	
Can manoeuvre a boat and perform an emergency stop.	
Understands the procedures to follow in case of an incident (Collison, Capsize, Abuse).	
Understands what may cause a capsize.	
Understands how to recover from a capsize (BR video of what to do in case of capsize).	
After an Outing	
Demonstrates safe lifting technique to remove boat from water and return to trestles and racking.	
Understands the significance of signing in correctly.	
Demonstrates boat cleaning and checks for damage.	
Understands system for reporting damage.	
Understands how to report all incidents both within the club and to British Rowing.
